

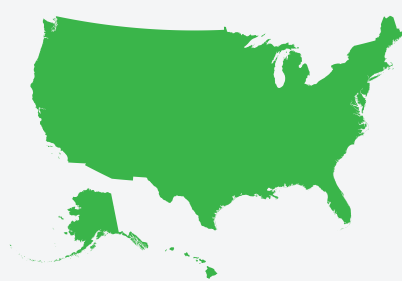

2017 National Truck Accident Trends

- There are **12.2 million** large trucks registered in the U.S.
- A total of **148,000 people** are injured in truck accidents.
- **4,761** = the number of people killed in large truck crashes, including:
 - **3,175** people in other passenger vehicles
 - **372** pedestrians
 - **275** motorcyclists
 - **76** bicyclists
- **65%** of all fatal truck accidents occurred between **6 a.m. - 6 p.m.**
- **88%** of all truck accidents occurred on **weekdays.**
- **Speeding and distracted driving** were the **most common causes of fatal truck crashes.**



2017 Georgia Truck Accident Trends

- There were **195** fatal crashes involving large trucks, **169** of which involved multiple vehicles.
- **214** people were killed in fatal accidents with large trucks.
- A total of **225** large trucks were involved in fatal crashes.
- The fatal truck accident rate was **18.70 (per million people)** – compared to the national average of **13.01**.
