## **Types of Disfiguring Injuries in Georgia Car Accidents**

Not all injuries are visible, but for those who suffer disfigurement in a crash, the damage is both physical and emotional. Common causes of disfigurement in car accidents include:

- Severe lacerations requiring stitches or surgical repair
- Facial injuries from shattered glass or steering wheel impact
- Burns from engine fires, airbag chemicals, or hot fluids
- Crush injuries requiring amputation or reconstructive surgery
- Road rash and skin abrasions in high-speed or ejection crashes

These injuries can leave permanent scars, especially on the face, arms, legs, or other exposed areas. Even with plastic surgery or skin grafts, the appearance may never fully return to normal.

#### The Emotional and Psychological Toll of Disfigurement
