

Tractor-Trailer Accidents Involving School Buses

Why Tractor-Trailers Are So Dangerous Near School Buses

Commercial trucks are dangerous enough under normal traffic conditions. But around school buses—where frequent stops, unpredictable child movement, and loading zones are common—they require even more caution.

The average school bus weighs 24,000–36,000 pounds when empty. A loaded tractor-trailer can weigh up to 80,000 pounds. When these vehicles collide, the results are catastrophic.

Factors that make tractor-trailers especially dangerous around school buses include:

- **Longer Stopping Distances:** Trucks need more time and space to come to a full stop, especially at higher speeds.
- **Driver Blind Spots:** A truck driver may fail to see a stopped or turning school bus, particularly at dawn or dusk.
- **Impaired or Distracted Driving:** Even a momentary lapse in attention can lead to a high-speed rear-end crash.
- **Failure to Obey School Bus Laws:** Georgia law requires all drivers to stop when a school bus is picking up or dropping off children (with limited exceptions), yet truck drivers sometimes ignore this.

What Causes Truck vs. School Bus Accidents?

While every crash is unique, there are several recurring themes in school bus collisions involving commercial trucks:

1. **Speeding or Driving Too Fast for Conditions:** Truckers who fail to slow down near school zones or rural bus stops risk catastrophic rear-end crashes.
2. **Inattentive or Distracted Driving:** Texting, GPS use, or daydreaming behind the wheel can lead a trucker to overlook a stopped school bus with flashing lights.

3. **Fatigue or Drowsiness:** A tired driver might miss visual cues or have slower reaction times. Federal law limits truck driver hours, but [violations](#) still happen.
4. **Mechanical Failure:** Worn [brakes](#), faulty lights, or [bad tires](#) can prevent a truck from stopping in time, even if the driver reacts quickly.
5. **Poor Visibility or Weather:** Fog, rain, or darkness can obscure a stopped bus, especially if the truck's headlights or mirrors are misaligned or dirty.

Injuries in School Bus and Truck Collisions

While school buses are designed to be structurally safe, they are often not equipped with seat belts, especially in older models or rural districts. In a crash with a semi-truck, children and drivers are at high risk of injury, including:

- [Traumatic brain injuries \(TBIs\)](#) caused by sudden impact or ejection
- [Spinal cord injuries](#) and fractures
- [Internal bleeding](#) or organ damage
- Lacerations and [broken bones](#)
- Post-traumatic stress and long-term emotional trauma
