

## Who's at Fault When a Car Pulls Out in Front of You and Causes a Crash?

### What Happens When a Driver Pulls Out Too Soon?

When a driver pulls into traffic without enough space or time, it often leads to a [rear-end](#) or [T-bone collision](#). These crashes are especially common near [intersections](#), shopping centers, and neighborhood exits where drivers try to "beat the gap." It's a gamble that too often ends with innocent motorists paying the price.

Even at moderate speeds, a vehicle pulling out in front of another can cause catastrophic injuries. The striking driver has little time to react, while the turning driver absorbs the full force of the crash on the side of their vehicle, which is one of the most vulnerable areas for occupants. It's like trying to merge onto a racetrack from a standstill: the margin for error is razor-thin, and one bad judgment call can create chaos.

### Who's at Fault When a Vehicle Pulls Out in Front of You?

In most Georgia cases, the driver who failed to yield the right-of-way bears the majority of the fault. [State law](#) requires all motorists to ensure traffic is clear before entering a lane, intersection, or highway. That means drivers pulling from side streets, driveways, or parking lots must wait until it's completely safe to proceed.

However, fault isn't always black and white. Insurance companies often argue that the oncoming driver was [speeding](#), [distracted](#), or could've avoided the crash. ### What Types of Crashes Happen When Someone Pulls Out in Front of You?

- **Rear-End Collisions:** When the front vehicle pulls out suddenly, the approaching car can't brake in time, leading to severe [whiplash](#) or [spinal injuries](#).

Each crash type requires its own evidence strategy. For instance, a rear-end collision might rely heavily on skid mark analysis and reaction-time studies, while a side-impact case could hinge on intersection camera footage or witness positioning.

### Why Do Drivers Misjudge Gaps in Traffic?

### Can the Striking Driver Still Be Found at Fault?

It's possible, and insurance companies often try to argue it. They may claim the oncoming driver was speeding or distracted and therefore partly responsible. Georgia follows a modified comparative negligence rule, meaning you can still recover damages if you're less than 50 percent at fault, but your compensation is reduced by your percentage of fault.

For example, if you're awarded \$100,000 and found 10 percent at fault, your recovery becomes \$90,000. That's why proving fault clearly is crucial. ### **What Injuries Are Common in Pullout Collisions?**
